Adults who, by reason of an impairment or insufficiency of their personal faculties, are not in a position to protect their interests

Adult protection measures

All measures and instruments used for the purpose of adult support, legal representation or protection against abuse

Setting the scene 2/4

Art 12 CRPD

1. (...) PD have the right to recognition everywhere as persons before the law.

2. (...) PD enjoy legal capacity on an equal basis with others in all aspects of life.

3. States Parties shall (...) provide access by PD to the support they may require in exercising their legal capacity.

4. (...) all measures that relate to the exercise of legal capacity provide for appropriate and effective safeguards to prevent abuse (...). (M)easures relating to the exercise of legal capacity respect the rights, will and preferences of the person, are free of conflict of interest and undue influence, are proportional and tailored to the person's circumstances, apply for the shortest time possible and are subject to regular review (...). The safeguards shall be proportional (...).

5. (...) States Parties shall take all (...) measures to ensure the equal right of persons with disabilities to own or inherit property, to control their own financial affairs and to have equal access to bank loans, mortgages and other forms of financial credit, and shall ensure that persons with disabilities are not arbitrarily deprived of their property.

- Paradigm shift ?

 - Protection \rightarrow Autonomy

 - State-ordered or by operation of the law \rightarrow Voluntary

Voluntary Measures 1/2

Voluntary measures

Any measure initiated by the adult without external compulsion, by operation of the law or a decision by any competent state authority

Continuing power of attorney

A mandate given with the purpose that it shall remain in force, or enter into force, in the event of the granter's incapacity



Voluntary Measures 2/2

State-Ordered Measures 1/4

State-ordered measures

Adult protection measures, ordered by a competent state (judicial or administrative) authority, at the request of the adult or others



State-Ordered Measures 2/4

- Grounds
- Measures
 - Guardianship
 - Legal capacity
- Procedure
 - Competent authority
 - Initiative
 - Expertise
 - Participation rights



State-Ordered Measures 3/4

- Who can be a guardian
- Competences of the guardian
 - General
 - Financial matters
 - Personal matters
 - Strictly personal matters

Measures by Operation of the Law 1/3

Ex-lege representation

An adult protection measure providing legal authority to natural or legal persons to act ex-lege (by operation of law) on behalf of the adult or to support the adult, requiring neither a decision by a competent authority nor a voluntary measure by the adult.
