### Student Accommodation Guide

This document will inform you of the different types of student accommodation for couples. Firstly, we will give you some criteria to think about, such as facilities and locations. Secondly, we will provide you with detailed information about each room type, such as rental prices, pictures, and size. The couple rooms are suitable for two VU students. It is possible to both register with the municipality at that address. We do not offer rooms for couples with children and/or pets.

There are very limited couple rooms available. **Note that all rooms are available with a fixed contract for a maximum period of one academic year! Contracts cannot be shortened or extended.** 

#### HOUSING CORPORATION

There are very limited couple rooms available. Most of the couples' rooms are part of DUWO Accommodate and are located at Cornelis Lelylaan, Pierre Lallementstraat and Uilenstede. We also have couples' rooms at OurCampus Amsterdam Diemen and BOLD (De Key).

The rent increase follows the inflation standard and will be around 5% plus possible VAT increase. Please note, due to the energy crisis in Europe the expectation is that there will be an increase in the service costs! The current service costs are included in the average price.

#### HOUSING ALLOWANCE

Housing allowance (huurtoeslag) is a subsidy provided by the Dutch government to tenants with a low income and a relatively high cost of rent. Some of the student rooms we provide qualify for housing allowance. Find out more about which housing types are eligible on the following pages. #### HOW TO APPLY

In your personal dashboard on vu.nl, you can register for housing and complete your application by selecting your preferred budget category and paying the housing fee. Please note that the budget category you choose does not limit your booking options, as you may still be able to choose from different available categories.

We will assign couples rooms on a first-paid, first-served basis (so based on the date on which we received the housing fee). After you have paid the housing fee, please contact us via e-mail, studentaccommodation@vu.nl, to let us know that you prefer a room for couples.

For many years, the DUWO Foundation has been the provider of student rooms in Amsterdam and various other cities in the Netherlands. With nearly 32,000 student rooms, DUWO is the largest student accommodation specialist in the Netherlands. The following pages will provide information about the various room types reserved at DUWO.

#### ADMINISTRATIVE FEE & FIRST INSTALLMENT

Please note that for every room type you have to make a one-time costs payment (which is non-refundable), this payment varies per housing provider (see table page 1). This payment includes contract costs, cleaning service, bed linen and a kitchen package. Moreover, the first instalment for all accommodation types at DUWO consists of 3 months of rent (the first and last two months of your contract).

# UILENSTEDE 172 🤓

Uilenstede Campus is a student district on the outskirts of Amsterdam, in the municipality of Amstelveen. The campus provides many amenities, such as a large cafe, supermarket, snack bar, bicycle repair shop, sports center, theatre, pizzeria, beauty salon & diving school. At Uilenstede you are living in the center of student life at the VU! As a nature enthusiast you will also have plenty to enjoy: Within a 5-minute bike ride you are in the Amsterdam Forest (amsterdamsebos.nl), which is no less than three times the size of Central Park in New York and (inter-)nationally known for the rowing games held on the Bosbaan. It is an excellent place to relax or play sports in the open, and all kinds of events and festivals are organized here. The Vrije Universiteit is nearby, just over 5 minutes by bicycle or in an equal time by metro or tram. You can reach the heart of Amsterdam in twenty minutes by bicycle, tram, or metro. You can do your laundry in the laundry room.

There is a laundry room, and you can park your bicycle in the bicycle storage room in the building. The Feniks is just a few minutes' walk from Amstel Station, where you can take the train, metro, bus, and tram. A few minutes' cycling and you are on the Middenweg, a pleasant shopping street in Watergraafsmeer with nice restaurants. You are also very close to the Wibautstraat with hip cafes and clubs. Within fifteen minutes of biking, you are in the heart of Amsterdam.

# CORNELIS LELYLAAN 🥯



In the Little Manhattan building in Amsterdam West, DUWO leases nearly 600 self-contained studios, half of which are for international students. The building is brand new and offers a beautiful view over the city from the higher floors. Of course, you can park your bike in the bicycle storage room and do your laundry in the laundry room. With Lelylaan station around the corner, the Cornelis Lelylaan is in an ideal location. Just a few steps will get you to the train, metro, bus or tram after you walk out the door, or you can cycle to the shopping centre at Delflandplein within a few minutes for your daily groceries. The famous club and event location De School is only a stone's throw away. Also, the Rembrandtpark is right around the corner.

## DE KEY – BOLD RESIDENCE

On the North-side of river IJ, a new upcoming district rises. Behind Central Station you will find De Key's new high sustainability building that goes by the name BOLD. At BOLD you can live in a fully furnished studio with a modern vibe. It offers housing for individuals and a few couple rooms at a convenient location. All studio's feature a compact kitchen and private bathroom. There is a communal laundry facility and bike storage.

BOLD is a very sustainable and eco-friendly building, each room has approximately 30 minutes warm water (think shower, washing dishes, etc.) per day, which is sufficient for most people. Please note that BOLD is a new building and construction is still ongoing around the area.
