Concerning: Approval of Adjustment 'Faculty's Regulations' regarding the transfer of Educational masters and master HGZO

Dear members of Faculty Board,

The Employee Council (ODC) of the Faculty of Behavioral and Movement Sciences has examined the request for adjustment of the Faculty's Regulations in order to accommodate the transfer of two educational master's, master *Educatie in de Taal en Cultuurwetenschappen* (ETC) from the Faculty of Humanities and master *Educatie in de Mens- en Maatschappijwetenschappen* (EMMW)) from the Faculty of Social Sciences, to the Faculty of Behavioral and Movement Sciences. Furthermore, we have examined the request for adjustment regarding transfer of master HGZO from the Faculty of Behavioral and Movement Sciences to Medical Faculty. Both transfers have been discussed in the Joint Meeting on June 18, 2019.

We formally agree with the first adjustment in regulations regarding the transfer of two educational master's.

In the Joint Meeting, we have indicated that we find the second adjustment in regulations regarding the transfer of master HGZO premature since the transfer process remains quite complex and uncertain. Since the Faculty Board has informed us that implementing the adjustment at this point is driven by efficiency, we formally agree with the adjustment as long as it is clear that this change is conditional upon the approval from the Executive Board of the Vrije Universiteit Amsterdam (CvB).
