

Preface

Our strengths

In a history that spans almost 150 years, Vrije Universiteit Amsterdam has become a fully-fledged university with nine faculties on one single campus. Across a number of academic disciplines, researchers at VU Amsterdam are among the best in the world. Our university offers an attractive environment for research with the potential to have a major impact, both scientifically and in society as a whole.

VU Amsterdam has three particular strengths that set it apart from other universities.

Identity and history

Academic freedom has always been a cornerstone of VU Amsterdam's philosophy. The university attracts free thinkers who are connected with each other and with society. VU Amsterdam encourages a deep awareness of diversity and a wider sense of purpose. The university sees and values others for who they are. We are curious, dynamic and societally engaged. In our research we are meticulous, responsible and transparent. We have a critical attitude and are open to criticism. All of these aspects find expression in our three core values - Responsible, Open and Personally engaged.

Leading multidisciplinary, interdisciplinary and transdisciplinary research

In the Netherlands and abroad, VU Amsterdam is a pioneer in multidisciplinary, interdisciplinary and transdisciplinary collaboration across all fields of research. We believe in the power of collaboration between disciplines and between science and practical application. At the intersections between disciplines and between science and the wider world, new insights, impulses and perspectives lead to scientific and societal innovations. That is why we encourage cooperation in our interfaculty and interdisciplinary research institutes and in academic collaborative centres. Together with our collaborative partners, VU Amsterdam has all it takes to ensure that its research leads to scientific progress and helps solve complex societal problems.


Responsible research with integrity, and scientific and societal impact

Our ambitions

Through our research, we aim to find answers to scientific and societal questions. We want to push boundaries. To achieve our research vision, we have formulated six ambitions. Through these ambitions, VU Amsterdam wants to create an attractive research environment that drives both scientific and societal advances.

Scientific impact

VU Amsterdam is a nationally and internationally recognized university with the highest standards. VU Amsterdam is committed to strengthening the scientific impact of its research. VU Amsterdam is dedicated to advancing its scientific position and reputation in the world.

Societal impact

Through its high-quality, ground-breaking research, VU Amsterdam serves the wider interests of society and makes a lasting contribution to public values. VU Amsterdam encourages thoughtful research, both applied and aimed towards solving societal issues and basic research that does not focus directly on a specific target group or application.

Focus

VU Amsterdam determines the direction of its research based on four profile themes: 'Human Health & Life Sciences', 'Governance for Society', 'Connected World', and 'Science for Sustainability'. These themes reflect our focus and connect us both internally and with the world around us. A mission, vision and strategy have been formulated for each theme, taking full account of the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). The profile themes therefore invite intensive interdisciplinary cooperation in research across faculty boundaries, leading to a better world and forming a platform for cooperation with our societal partners.

Cooperation

To achieve its scientific and societal ambitions, VU Amsterdam encourages cooperation between its researchers, with researchers from other knowledge institutions, and with businesses, civic organizations and citizens. VU researchers therefore have to be able to work together professionally, proactively and constructively, in a spirit of teamwork. By emphasizing cooperation, VU Amsterdam aims

to advance the quality of research. Cooperation should also contribute to a sense of community and connection in the region, the Netherlands and around the world. By working together, we can maximize VU Amsterdam's value to society.

Recognition and reward

Through a forward-looking appraisal system and recruitment policy, VU Amsterdam recognizes and rewards diverse roles and teamwork. At VU Amsterdam, education, research, knowledge transfer and leadership are valued equally. Various career paths are available within teams, so that researchers are able to develop their specific talents and make a difference within those contexts.

Open Science

Based on the conviction that knowledge and science should be accessible and transparent, we stand for the principles of Open Science. VU Amsterdam strives to publish exclusively in open access. As research becomes increasingly data-driven, research protocols, data and analyses have to be made accessible across the full breadth of the university and in compliance with the FAIR principles: they must be Findable, Accessible, Interoperable and Reusable. By taking this approach, we explore the opportunities that digitization and datafication offer for research, while maintaining awareness of the threats to data ownership and the public values on privacy and security.



Preconditions

The local, regional, national and international landscape in which VU Amsterdam operates is changing rapidly. The same applies to how we carry out our research. In maintaining our position and achieving our ambitions, talent makes all the difference: we want to attract ambitious, talented researchers and forge a bond between them and our university. To respond effectively to the latest developments, we are modernizing the ways in which our research is financed, equipped and supported, so that we can operate flexibly and decisively.

We are also experimenting with new ways of working in the post-Covid era: these include alternating between working from home and on campus, new facilities for meetings, and deploying new technologies that further our sustainability ambitions. Through new ways of working and new facilities, we want to make it as easy and attractive as possible for our researchers to work effectively, collaborate and to be part of the VU community.

Research funding

Solid research funding is essential to enable research into reflective, fundamental and topical areas, and to earn and maintain our position at the forefront of science. Through cooperation and bringing in assignments from outside the university, we will intensify our focus


on obtaining indirect and contract research funding. We will also use the VU Fund to increase the financial security and stability for research funding.

Research infrastructure

State-of-the-art research facilities are crucial to high-quality research.
Independently or in collaboration with others, VU Amsterdam is investing in specific research facilities that reflect its scientific and societal mission.
VU Amsterdam is working to ensure that these resources are used as intensively as possible by internal and external parties.

Research support

With knowledge and expertise we support our researchers in their efforts to find and apply for research grants, in the execution of grant projects awarded and in the knowledge transfer of results. In addition, VU Amsterdam supports its researchers with tools, facilities and technical support in all other research-related areas, such as research data management, access to and maintenance of technical equipment, the use of software and compliance with policy and regulations. We achieve this through personal advice, training and technical support.
