

Amendment to the Student Personal Data Processing Regulations Vrije Universiteit Amsterdam

The Student Personal Data Processing Regulations Vrije Universiteit Amsterdam will be amended as follows:

I

Article 3.2, under o, will read as follows:

o. Fraud control and time control with online supervision of examinations and tests in the first semester of the academic year 2021-2022 (online proctoring).

II

In Article 4.1, section k, is added:

k. In online examinations, including online examinations with online supervision of examinations and assessments (online proctoring) in the first semester of the academic year 2021 - 2022, when the Data Subject takes the examination: video and audio recordings of the Data Subject, video and audio recordings of the room in which the Data Subject is located, video recording of the student card, technical specifications computer, active software, screen activity, IP address and internet pages that the Data Subject visits during the examination.

III

This amendment will enter into force as soon as it has been adopted by the Executive Board after approval by the USR and will cease to apply on 1 January 2023, on the understanding that:

- the online remote monitoring will be deployed in the first semester of the academic year 2021-2022; and
- the personal data collected up to that point will be processed (further) after that period until 1 January 2023 at the latest, insofar as this is necessary for examinations, objection and appeal procedures or statutory duties of the Vrije Universiteit Amsterdam.
