Usage regulations Islamic Prayer Room

Purpose

The Islamic prayer room is used for prayer and meditation.

Access

The room is open to students, staff and guests of Vrije Universiteit Amsterdam, but may be entered only without shoes.

Use

- During prayer hours, visitors are requested to be mindful of prayer.
- Literature in the room is limited to the usual literature in a prayer room. No other literature without prior permission.
- In the ladies and men's area of the prayer room, facilities are provided for ritual ablution (wuḍū'). The toilet groups cannot be used for this purpose.
- Information and communication of activities by means of flyers, posters or other physical expressions is not permitted.
- No eating or drinking is allowed in the room due to vermin.

Supervision and management

- Vrije Universiteit Amsterdam has appointed Batuhan Türkmen (CIT-VU) for the Friday afternoon prayer. He is also available on a limited basis for student counseling and support. He can be reached at: mailto:gebedsruimte@vu.nl.
