VU – UVA Honours programme; mission statement

- 1. The Honours programme is embedded in the profile and strategy of both universities and in the portfolios of the faculties
- 2. The Honours programme is extracurricular and provides challenging and generally small-scale education
- 3. The focus of the Honours programme is on the development of personal skills, leadership skills, entrepreneurship, and collaboration
- 4. Attention is given to *academic citizenship* and the future role of students as an academic in society
- 5. The Honours programme pays attention to diversity and inclusivity, using the mixed and international classroom methods
- 6. Participation in the Honours programme is based on reciprocity: students receive something extra and give something back (e.g., students develop a course and therefore also contribute to innovation in education, or students give back to society by participating in community service learning)
- 7. The Honours programme contributes to innovation in education
- 8. Students are committed to the Honours programme and have an active approach: they are expected to complete the Honours programme
- 9. The Honours programme consists of a disciplinary and an interdisciplinary part. A university-wide Honours programme is the perfect breeding ground for interdepartmental subject content, and to connect lecturers from different disciplines
- 10. Participation in the Honours programme is based on selection and generally the language of the Honours programme is English.
- 11. Honours students are encouraged to build a strong Honours community, and this is facilitated by faculties, and both universities.
