This is an overview of who to adress with your problems.	
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• If you can not resolve the problem with the person concerned, and consultation of your supervisor (SV) and her/his supervisor does not help either, you can use this overview as an additional referral guideline.

- Do not hesitate to contact the person who you think can help best. Because functions overlap, you might be referred to the right person.
- When you require acute help (emergency) call the VU emergency number: 22222 (internal) or 020 598 2222 (external/cellphone).
- When the situation is not acute but may require practical measures (for example in case of 'Aggression and violence', 'Threat' or 'Stalking'), contact the Safety and Security Reporting Center.

Dark green: primary / most obvious 'counter'. Light green: the next obvious option.

Blue: always report to Safety and Security Reporting Center afterwards.
